Our Committee is pleased to present this Comprehensive Plan Review report to the public. The report is intended to update the community on the implementation of the original plan, which was initiated, discussed and approved in 1993-4. The report also deals with the threats and challenges Shelter Island faces as we move towards full build out, and recommends a wide range of actions for Town government to consider.

The report is organized in four main sections:

- Full Report: A twenty one page report, which includes a summary listing of the Action Points, originating with the 1993-4 Comprehensive Plan.

- Executive Summary: A nine page document which summarizes the main points of the report.
- Maps: See the attached 'Map Guide' and 'Map Overview' for detail on maps related to the Comprehensive Plan.

The report is best read in Adobe Reader, version 9 being the latest upgrade, which includes a 'search engine', which will enable you to find listings, such as 'wetlands', 'build out', and 'business'.
