

## Proposed Qualifications

To be qualified for community housing you must:

- Have lived full time on the island for at least 5 years and done volunteer work .
- spend/or have spent at least 75% of your time working on SI
- meet 'the established financial qualifications
- (Seniors) give/rent your current home to a qualified (X points or more) candidate
- US Citizen

Develop a point system so young families and/or seniors, who meet the above criteria, are long time/full time residents and have volunteered to help the island in different ways will have a chance at the housing. For example:

### Qualified Volunteer Work

- |          |   |

| 2 points | each year of active voluntary work for EMT or Fire Department                     |
| 1 point  | each year of active voluntary work for Meals on Wheels                            |
| 1 point  | each year as an active Hospice Volunteer  |
| 1 point  | each year of(non-paid) service on the Zoning Board, Assessors Board, School Board |

### Island Roots

- |          |  |

| 2 points | graduated from SI High School                      |
| 2 points | if your parents graduated from SI High School      |
| 2 points | if your grandparents graduated from SI High School |

### Necessary Services

- |          |   |

| 1 point  | for each year of paid service to the island for difficult to fill positions (teacher, police, librarian, nurse) |
| 2 points | for becoming/being a qualified Home Health Aid  |
| 1 point  | for each year working as a Home Health Aid  |

### Community Service (Optional)

| 1 point | each year of active voluntary work for the Library  |
| 1 point | each year coaching a school activity (sports, play) |
